da Vinci XI[®] Surgical System

The da Vinci XI® Surgical System is the next frontier for minimally invasive surgery. It is equipped with a 3D high definition (3D-HD) vision system, special instruments and computer software that allows surgeons to operate with enhanced vision, precision, dexterity and control.

MAKO Robotic-Assisted Surgery

MAKO provides surgeons with a patient-specific 3D model to pre-plan hip and knee procedures, enabling them to remove and replace only the diseased portion of the bone, and preserve healthy bone and ligaments surrounding the area.

Radiation Therapy Linear Accelerator

The Varian Linear Accelerators at ECHN's John A. DeQuattro Cancer Center provides state-of-the-art radiation therapy cancer treatments by offering three-dimensional intensity modulated radiation therapy for a more precise and targeted treatment.

Canon Vantage Orian™ MRI Imaging

ECHN's Vantage Orian™ boosts MRI imaging performance and productivity at 1.5T. This MRI offers outstanding patient comfort and confidence, as well as the largest portfolio of non-contrast imaging sequences available.



Laboratory Technology

The chemistry and hematology departments within ECHN's laboratory are fully automated. Approximately 85 different test samples can be received, prepared for testing and analyzed on a single automated line. This improves turnaround-time for testing, providing results to the clinicians in a very timely fashion.

Perspective 64-Slice CT

The latest in CT technology combines greater capability with a lower radiation dose. It can be used for lung cancer screenings, advanced 3D CT vascular imaging, CT imageguided biopsies, musculoskeletal CT imaging, orthopedic CT imaging and tumor cryoablation.

Interventional Radiology

ECHN's top-line interventional radiology suite provides minimally invasive treatments with guidance from medical imaging technology. In many cases, specialists in this department can eliminate the need for conventional surgery for a wide range of conditions.

Inpatient and outpatient services include emergency care, a comprehensive, personalized cancer center, diagnostic testing including PET scan capabilities, a broad range of surgical services and minimally invasive procedures including robotic surgery, a family birthing center with a dedicated neonatology unit, extensive behavioral health services including an inpatient adolescent behavioral health unit and inpatient dual diagnosis unit, a sleep disorders center and much more.

ECHN offers a wide variety of educational programs, support groups and invaluable family services.

Charity Care and Cash & In-Kind Donations

Family Development Center

The ECHN Family Development Center is comprised of seven grant-funded home visiting programs that assist parents in developing essential parenting skills while providing parent education, child development information, developmental screenings, playgroups and learning activities. Programs use the Parents as Teachers (PAT) curriculum which is a nationally recognized parent education and family support program serving families throughout pregnancy until their child enters kindergarten. Our staff is trained and certified as PAT Parent Educators who conduct

regular screenings for your child to assess their overall development, provide parent workshops, conduct parenting groups and provide information on resources in your community.

Community Partners

Community Cancer Care, located at the John A. DeQuattro Cancer Center, is a collaborative radiation therapy center with Hartford Hospital and Johnson Memorial Hospital, offering leading-edge radiation therapy treatment and support services.

Connecticut Children's Medical Center, located in Hartford, is affiliated with ECHN for pediatric and neonatal specialty services. The children's hospital also offers emergency pediatric consultation.

Corpcare Occupational Health, located in South Windsor, is a collaboration providing occupational health services to build and maintain a healthy workplace.

Evergreen Endoscopy partners with ECHN to provide gastrointestinal (GI) care, including both colonoscopy and endoscopy services.

Medical Transportation Services through Ambulance Service of Manchester, and Aetna Ambulance, is provided by a partnership between Manchester Memorial Hospital and Hartford Hospital.

RestorixHealth partners with ECHN to provide and manage the services offered by ECHN's Center for Wound Healing.

Tolland Imaging Center, a collaboration between ECHN, Johnson Memorial Hospital and Windham Hospital, we offer individualized service and use state-of-the-art imaging equipment.

Behavioral Health Services

Addiction Services

ECHN focuses on medically treating symptoms related to substance abuse as well as long-term mental health.

Adolescent and Adult Inpatient Units

ECHN has two adolescent units (ages 12 to 18), one young adult unit (ages 18 to 28), and one older adult unit (18+) for individuals who have a psychiatric diagnosis.

Adult & Older Adult Behavioral Care

Inpatient and outpatient behavioral health services tailored to fit the needs of adults and senior citizens.

Dual Diagnosis Inpatient Unit

For individuals 18 years old and up and is for adults diagnosed with substance use disorder and an underlying mental health disorder.

Adolescent and Adult Outpatient Care

Open access services for adolescents (ages 12 to 18) and adults (18+) is designed to decrease barriers to treatment and allows you to access outpatient behavioral health services when you want and need them.

Adolescent Clinical Day School Services

Provides a rich, relationally-based program in a smaller, more individualized setting. The school serves middle school and high school students, as well as students with transitional service needs.



Training Tomorrow's Professionals Today

The future health and wellness of the community relies on tomorrow's medical professionals. ECHN's numerous medical education programs provide a community-focused setting for young physicians and nurses to grow into their roles as eastern Connecticut's future healthcare providers.

Family Medicine Residency Program

As the only family medicine residency program east of the Connecticut river, we provide a community-focused clinical site for residents to learn the art and science of family medicine.

Higher Education Partners

Rotating through core clerkships, students receive a dynamic academic experience in a clinical setting.
